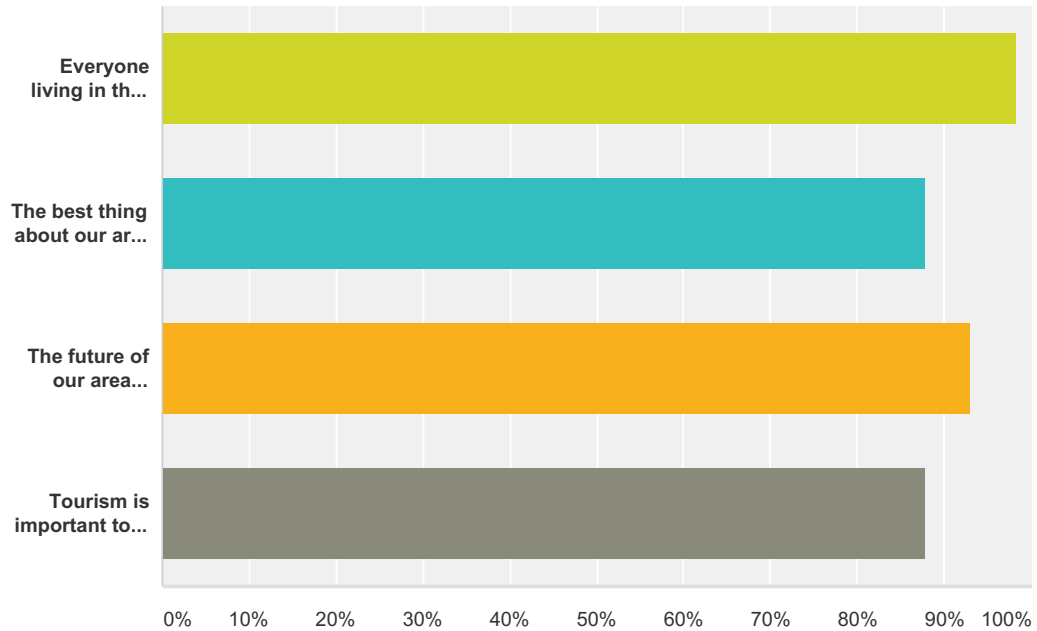

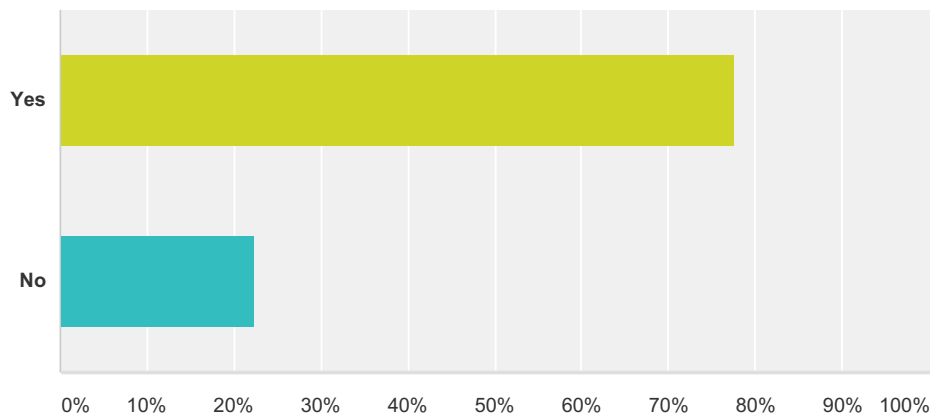

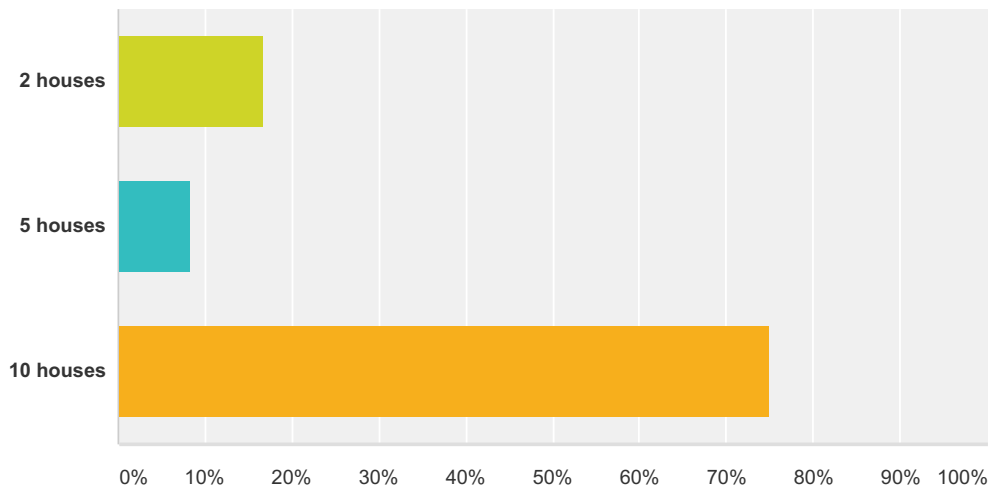

Q5 If you answered NO to question 4 and support more housing - how many?

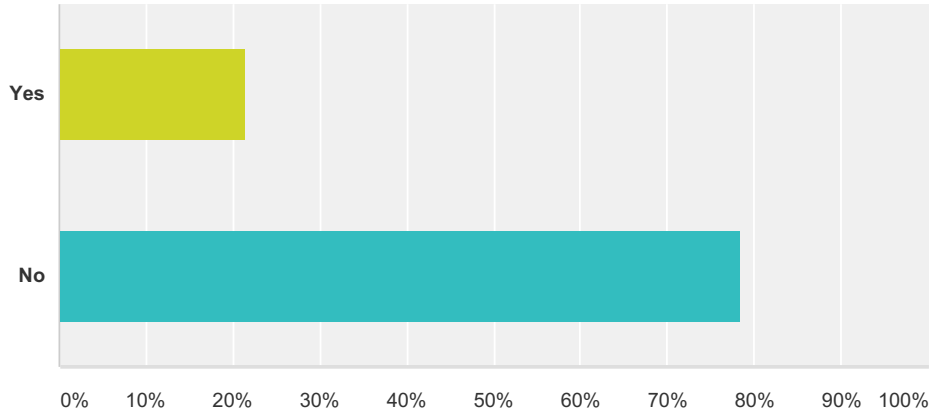

Q6 Do you have a close relative who would like to have their own home in the locality but can't because there is no appropriate housing available?

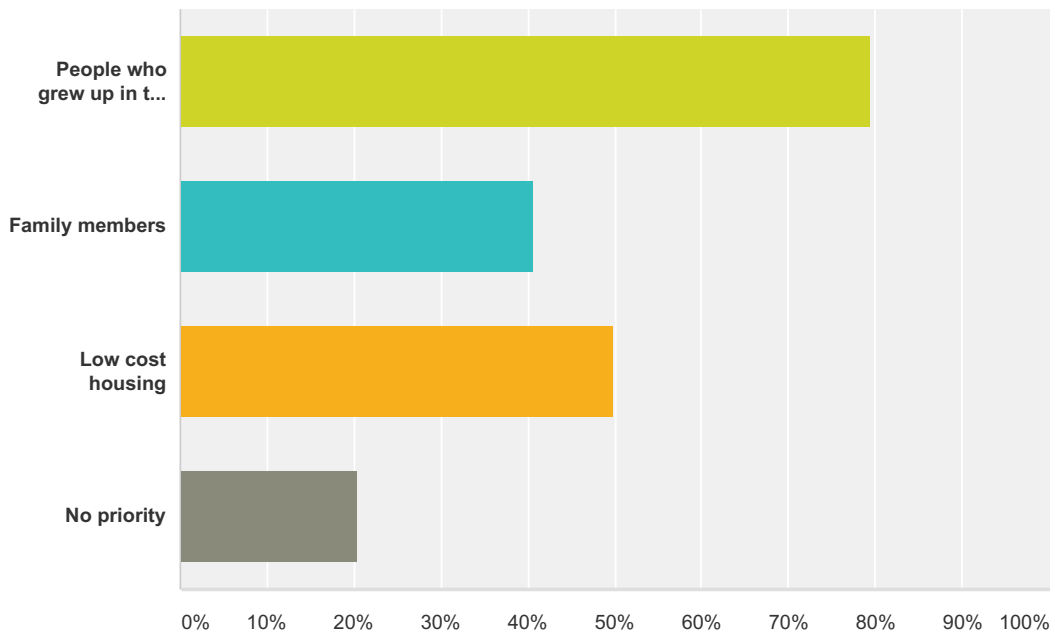

Q7 If new housing is built should there be a priority for: (Tick all that you agree with)

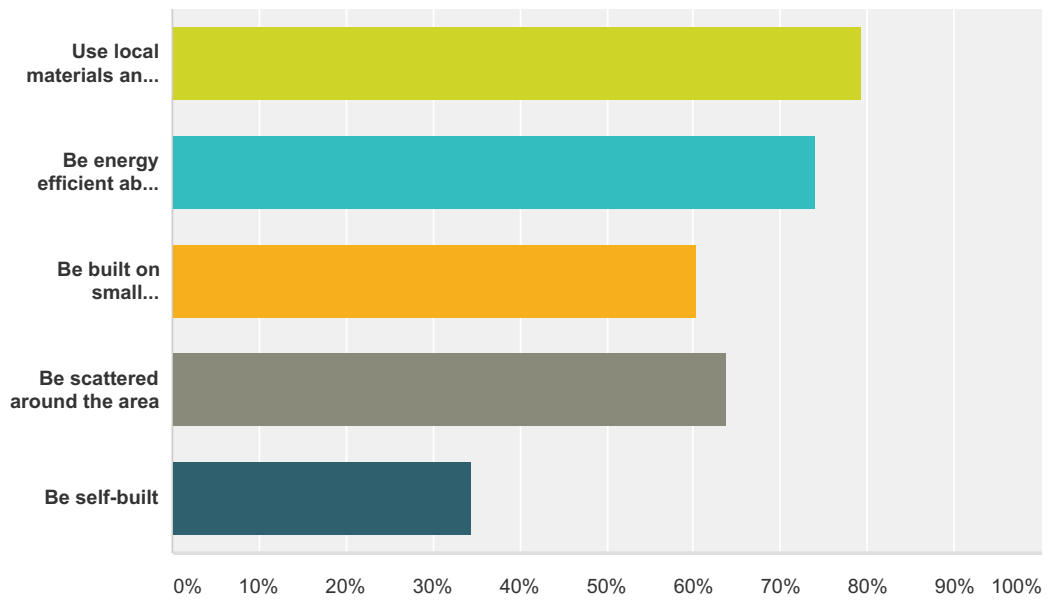

Q8 Do you think any new housing should.....(tick all that you agree with)

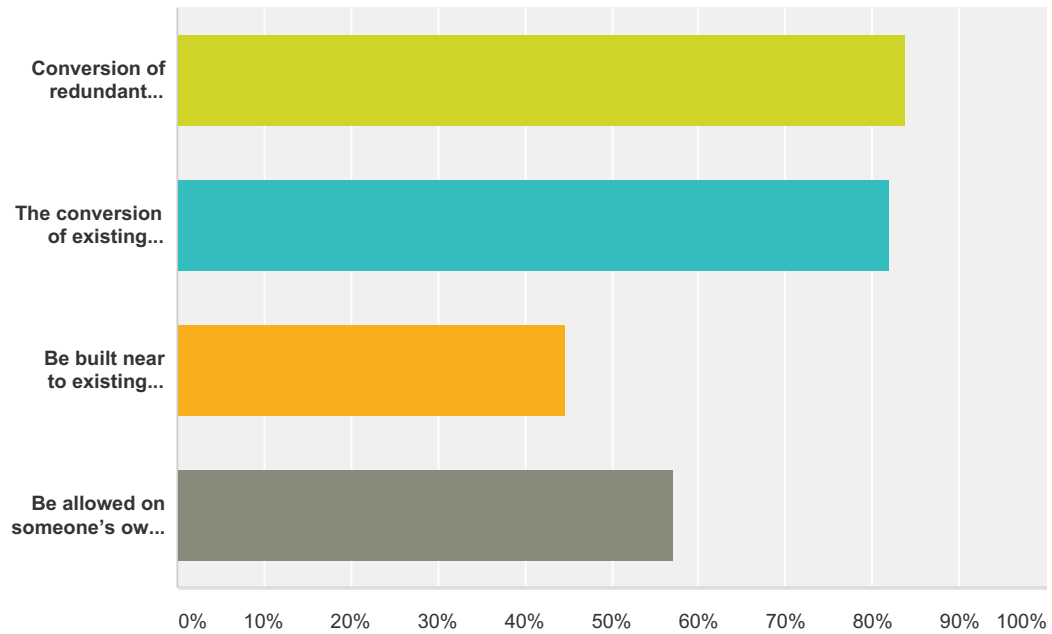

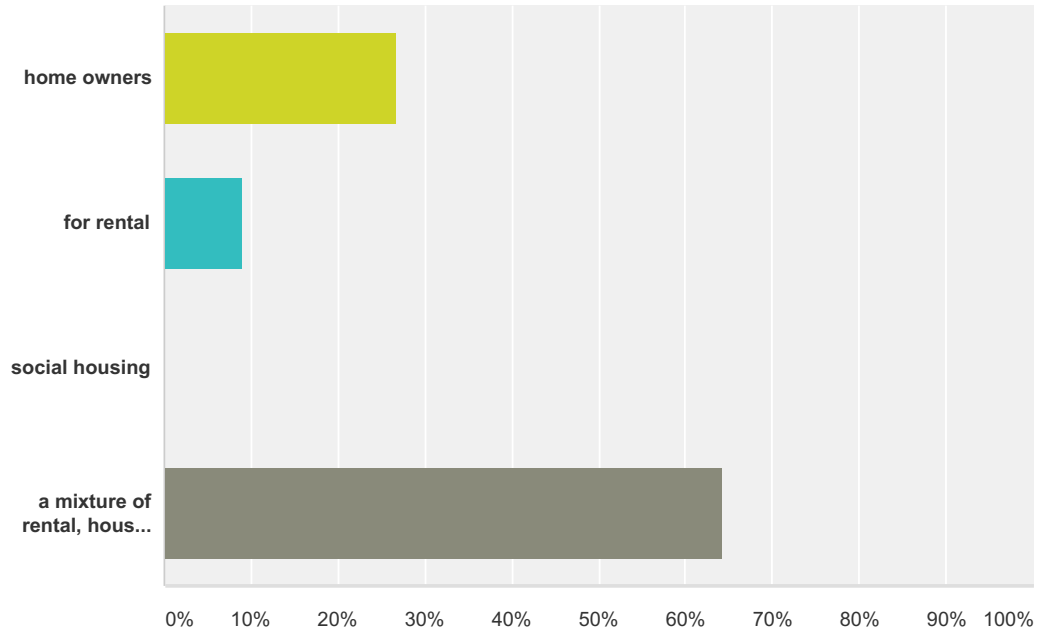

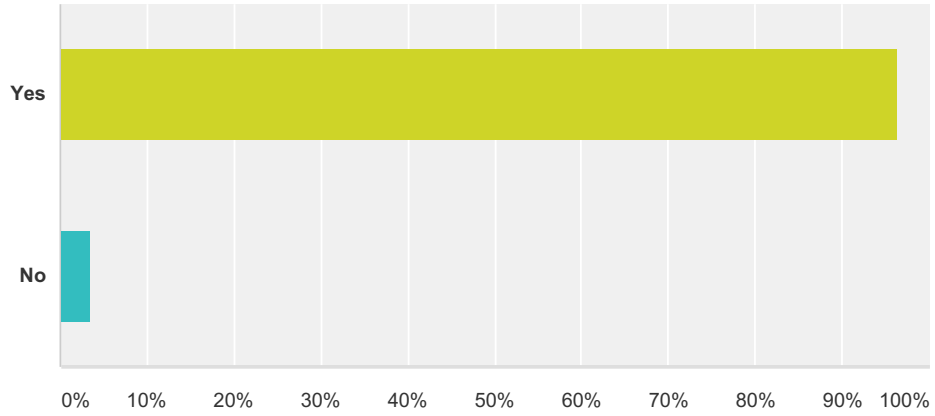

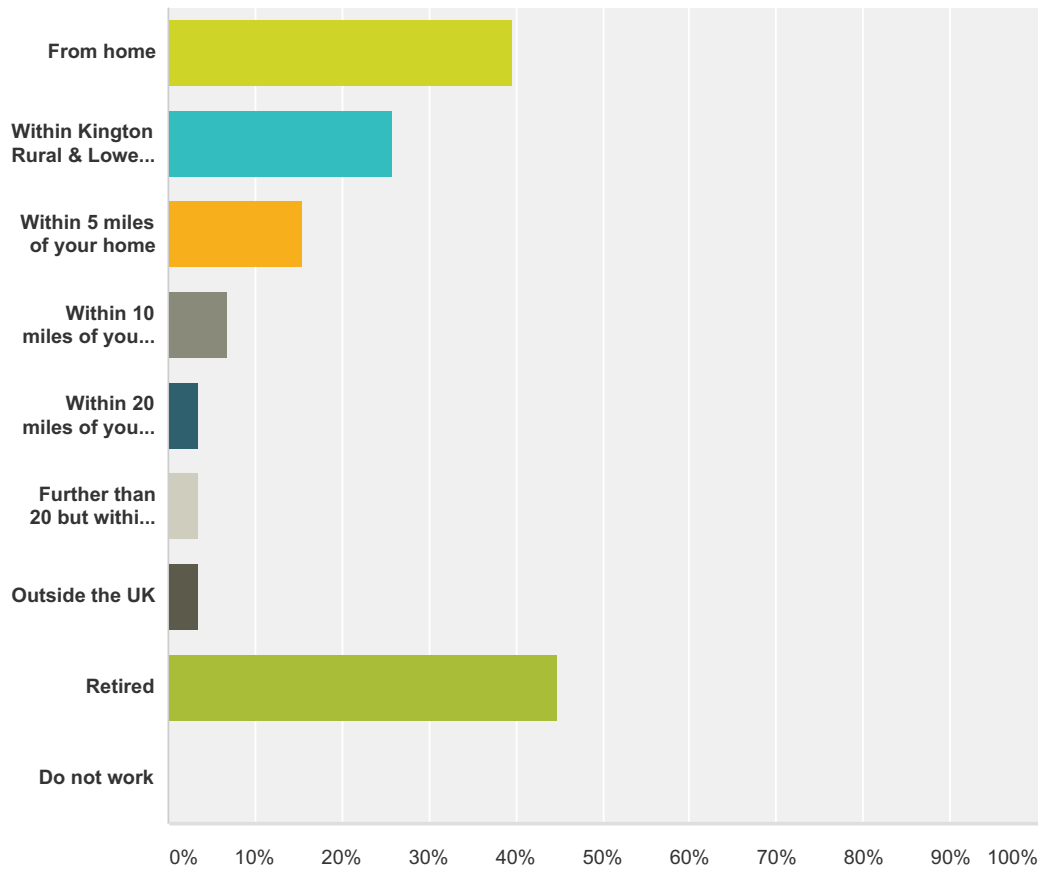

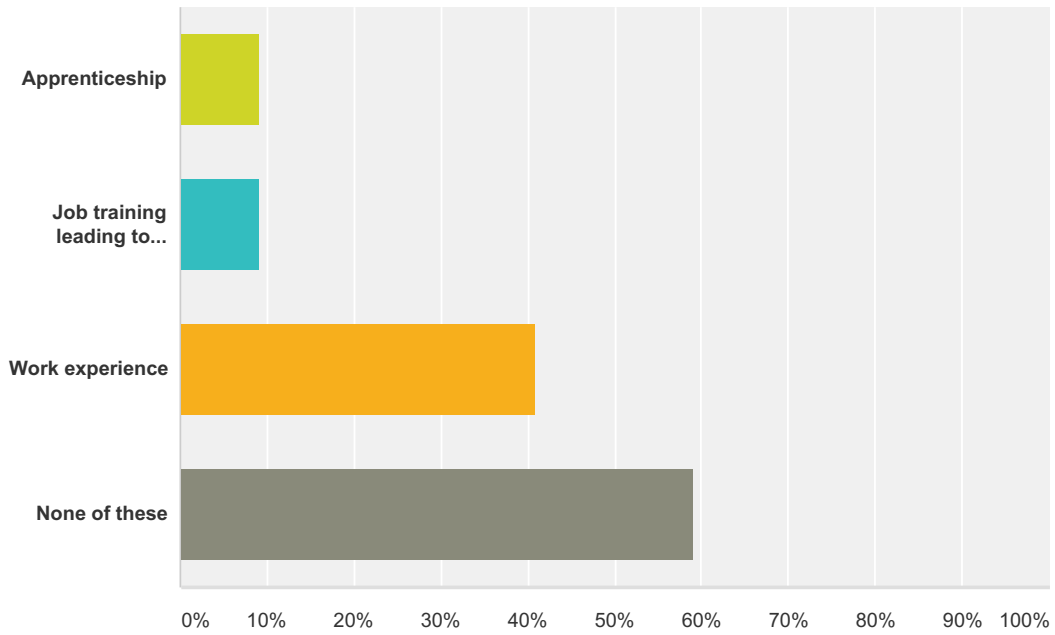

Q14 If you run your own business could you offer any of the following?

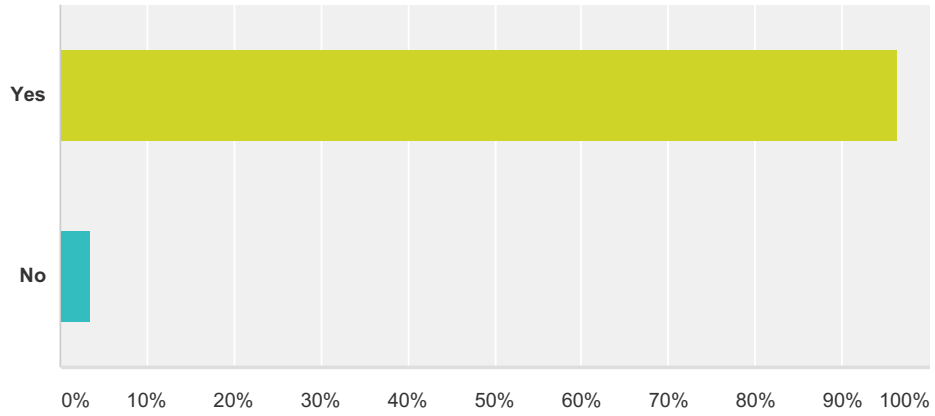

Q15 Do you feel that it is important that small family farms stay a feature of our community?

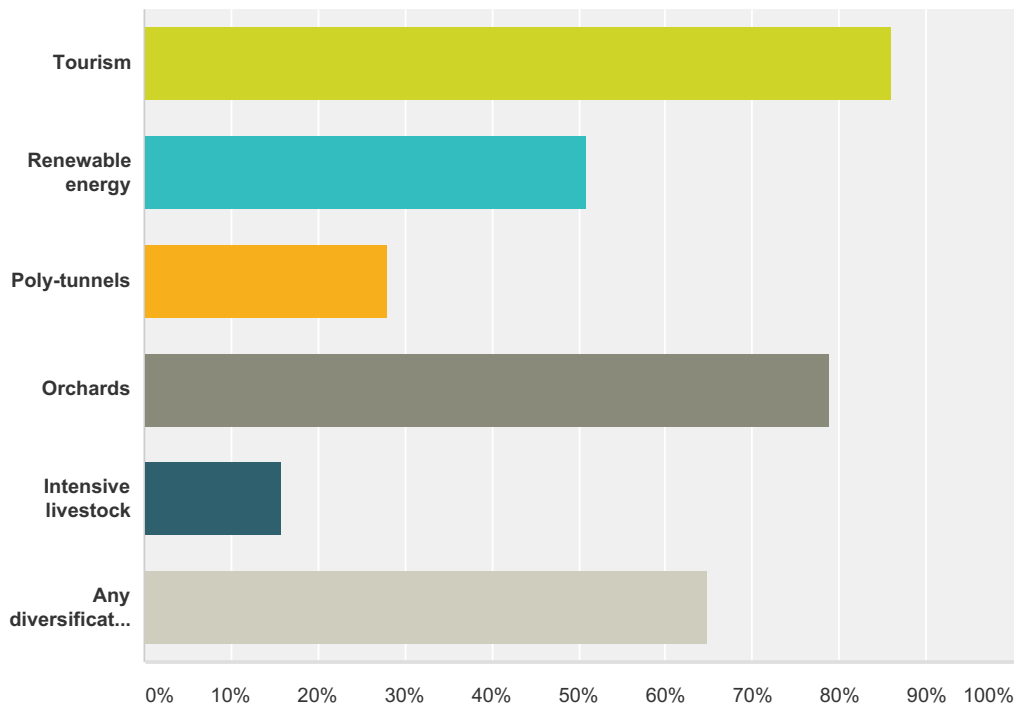

Q16 If farms are to survive as viable businesses in the area for the next generation, diversification might be necessary. What forms of diversification should be allowed? Tick all you think should be allowed

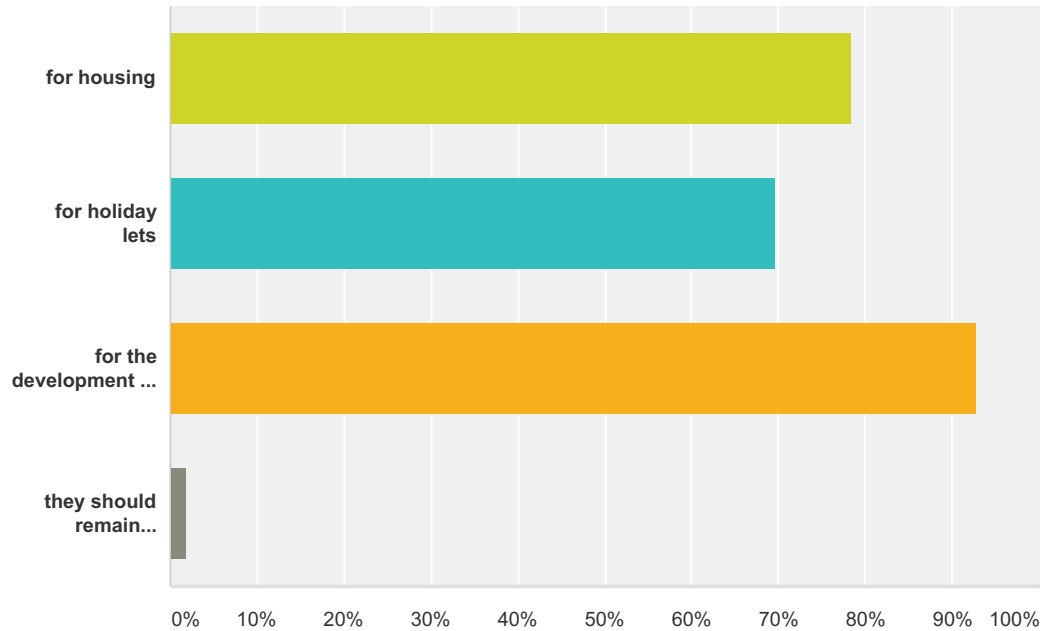

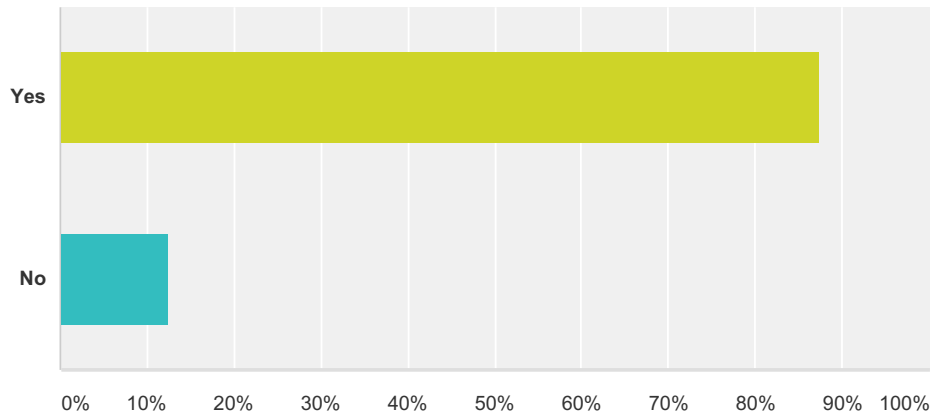

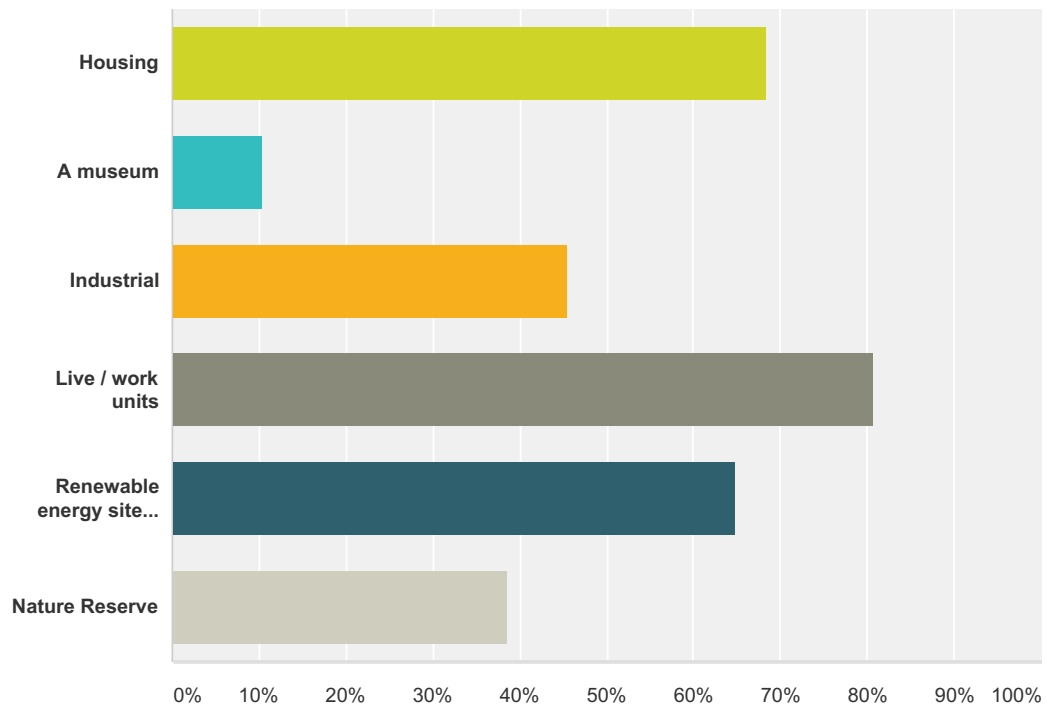

Q20 What do you think brownfield sites could be used for? (tick any you agree with)

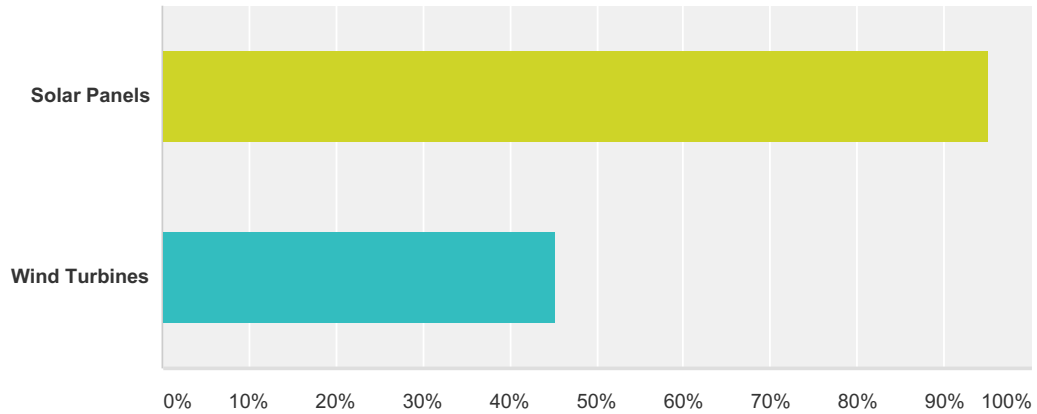

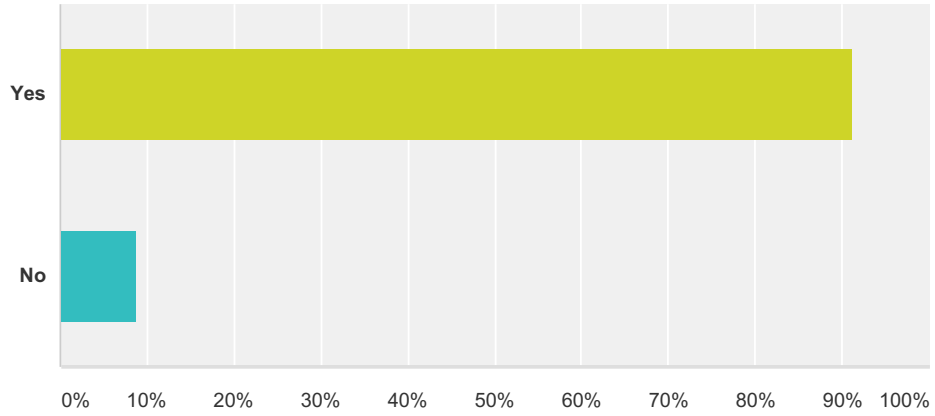

Q22 In Kington Rural & Lower Harpton Area tourism is increasingly important to the local economy. Should facilities for tourists be increased in the area?

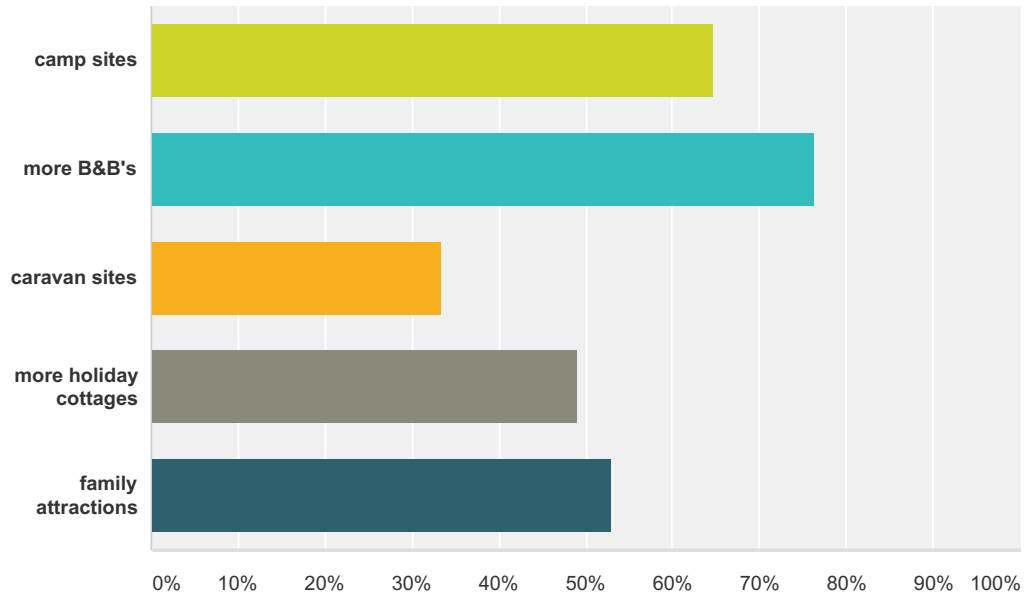

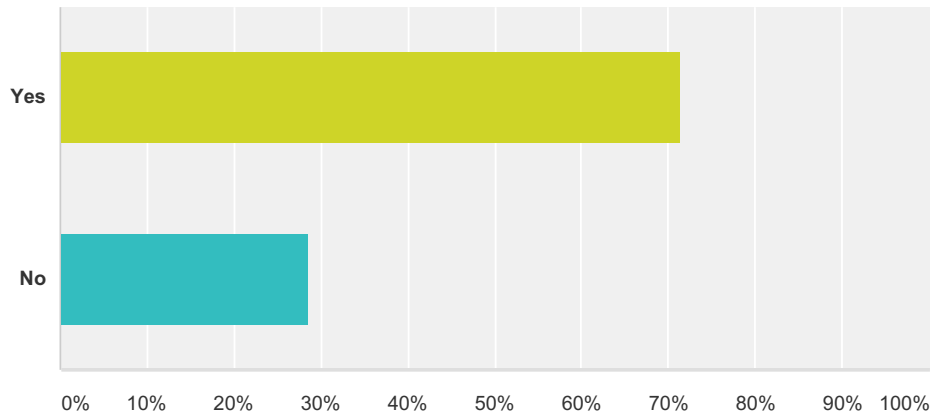

Q24 Are there enough footpaths in the area?

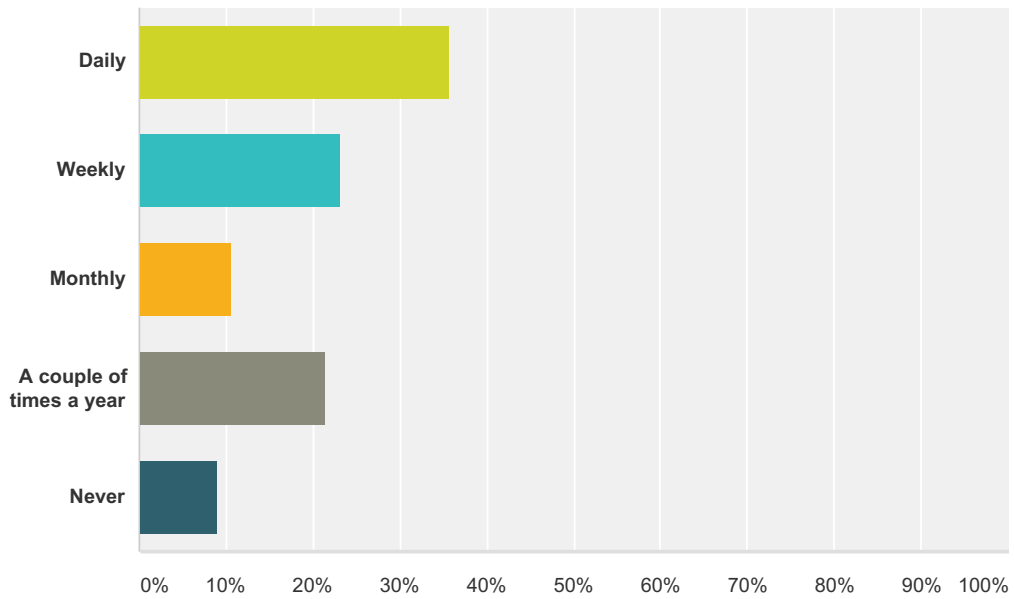

Q25 How often do you use the footpaths?

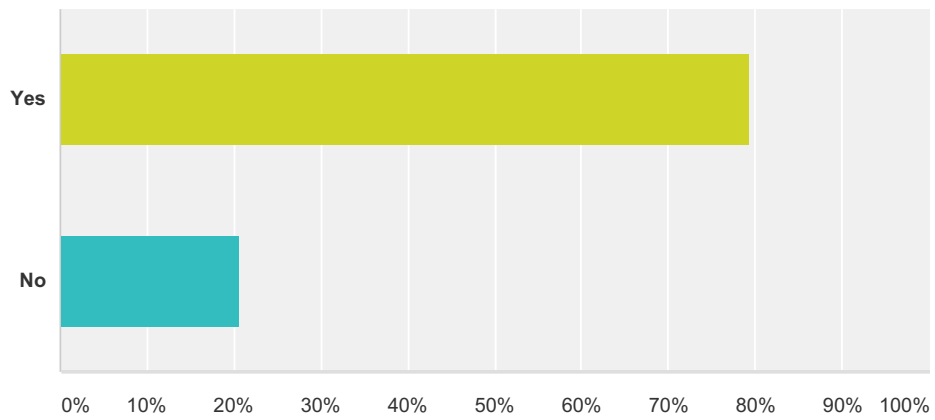

Q26 Is there a need for a footpath / cycle path along the Hergest Road to Arrow View

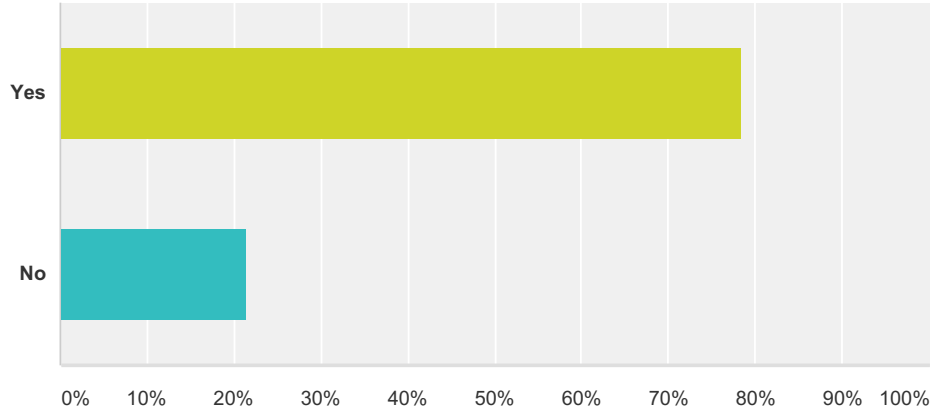

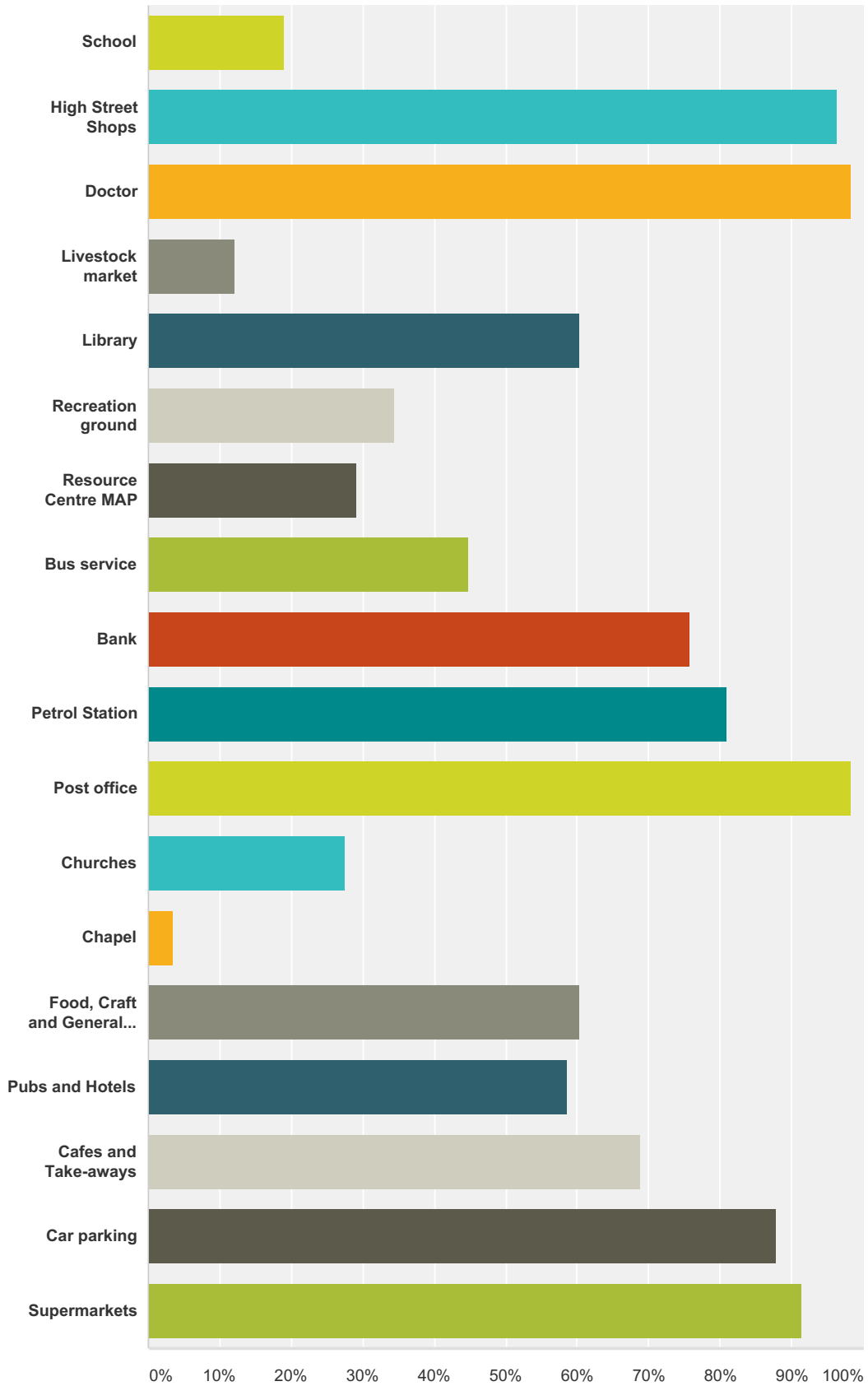

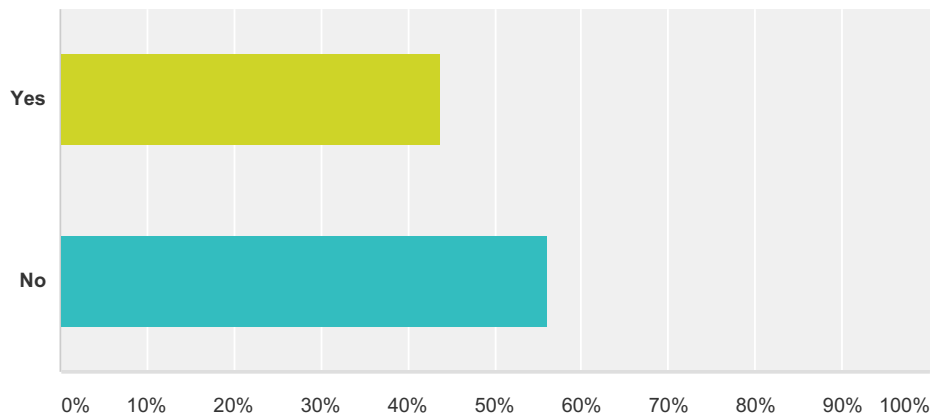

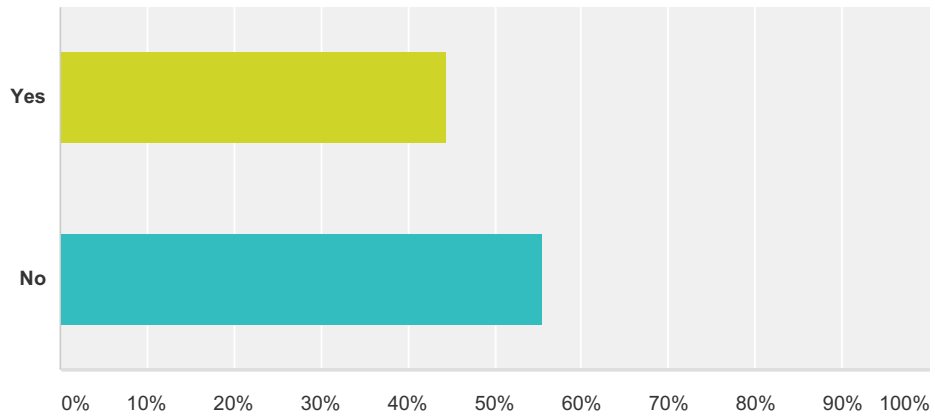

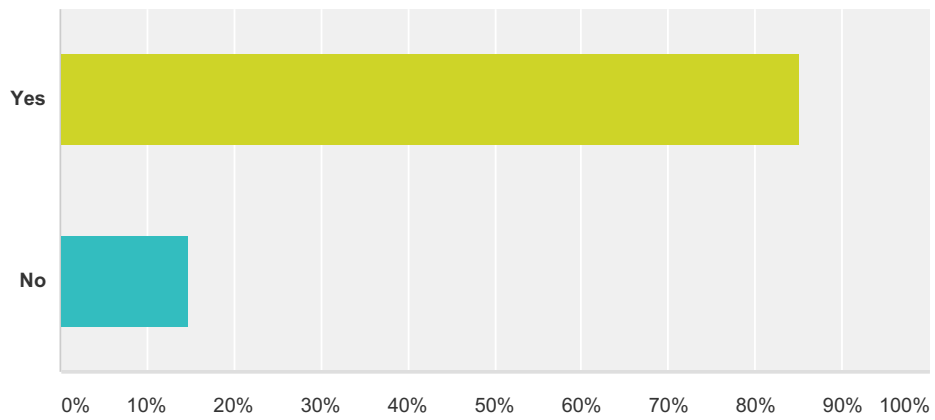

Q34 Do you feel that our area is adequately covered by the Fire service?

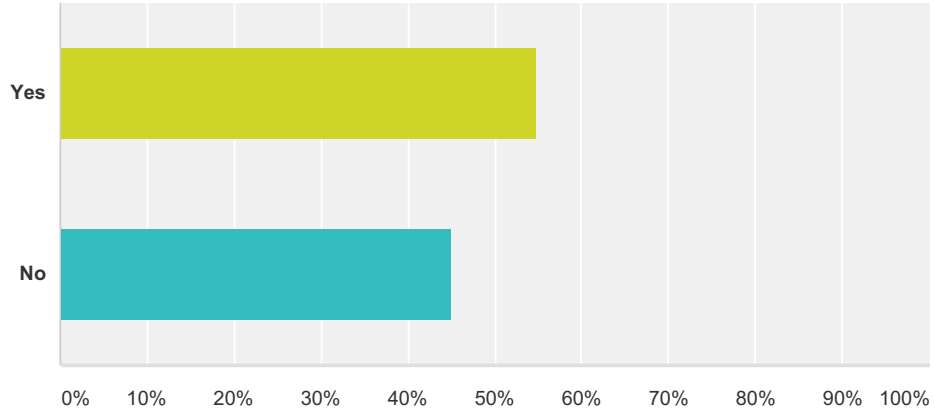

Q35 Do you feel that your area is adequately covered by the Ambulance Service?

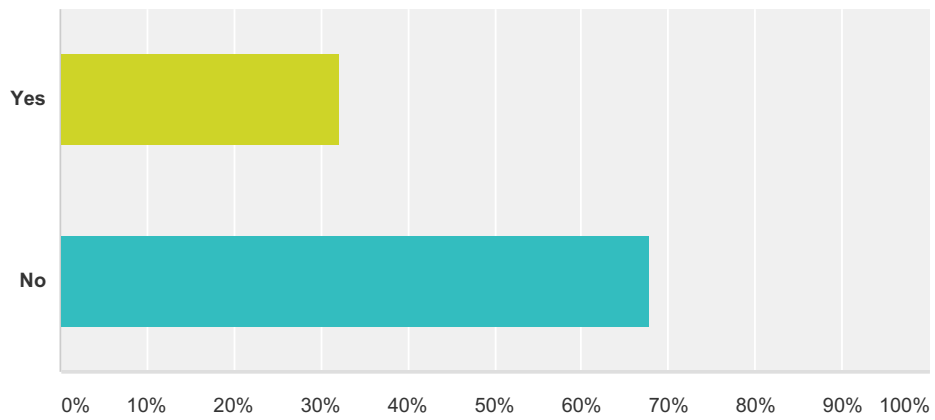

Q36 Do you feel that our area is adequately covered by the Police service?

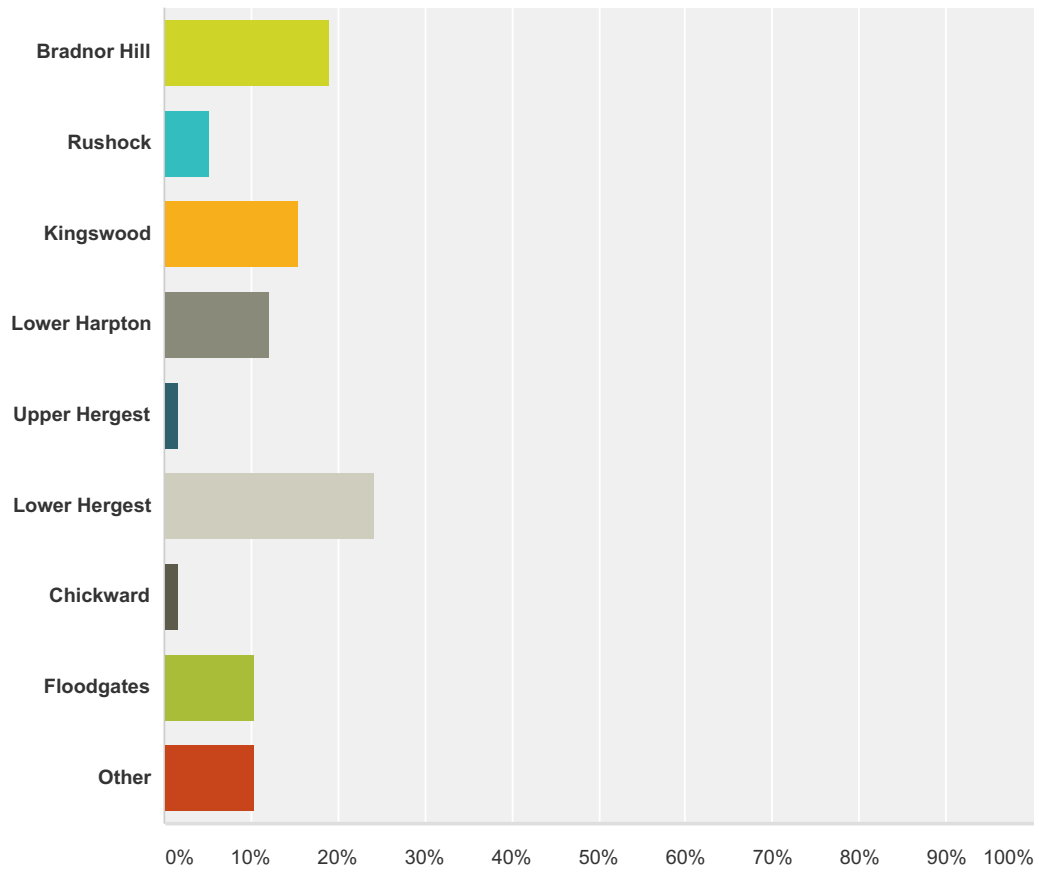

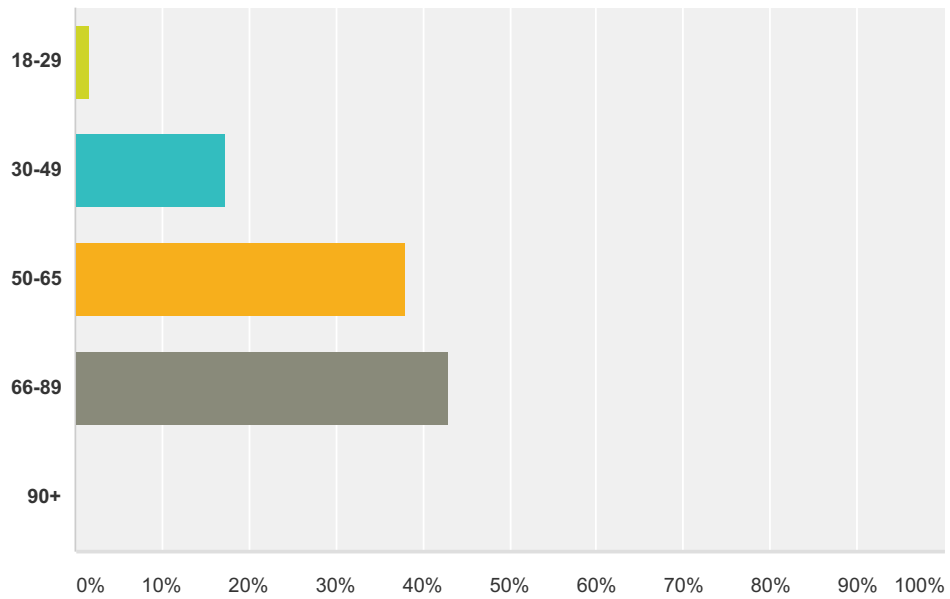

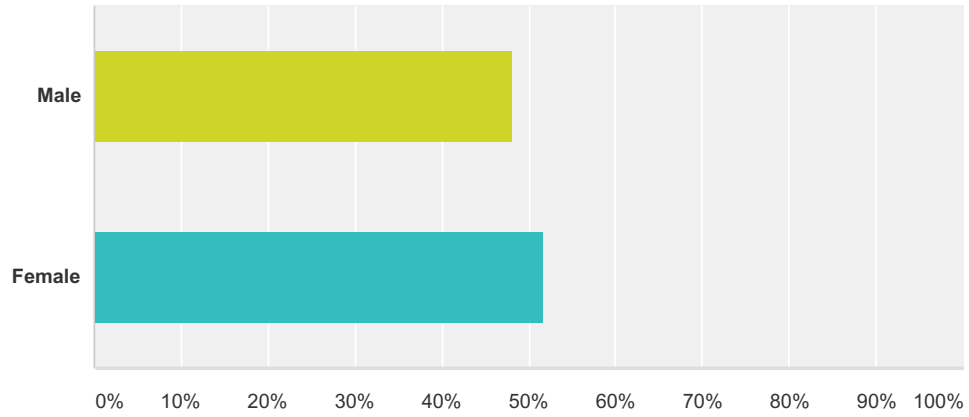
